Studio Packages - Studio sessions offer classica and contemporary portraits Great for seniors who need to fulfill yearbook requirements. Either session offers wardrobe changes and a variety of poses.

On-Location Packages - For the senior who wants a backdrops beyond the studio. From urban alleys to classic parks, options are endless! On-Location Pkg. 2 can include the studio and an outdoor location.

What you need to know!

As a still photographer, I understand that your senior portraits are unique to you. This is why I offer studio and on-location sessions to seniors. I want your senior portraits to be one of a kind.

I want you to get the most out of your session, so please take a moment to read some answers to the most frequently asked questions.

How should I prepare for my session?

Think of the location(s) you're wanting to have as back drops to your portraits. Throughout the years I have photographed seniors at many fun locations such as Irbine Park, the Rose Garden, Playgrounds, a client's backyard, a rail road track, a soccer field, funky allies and Summit Ave to name a few. Several are close to my studio in St. Paul. I am open to your ideas, but have recommendations as well. When selecting your locations, please note that I do not have a portable dressing room. Usually students wear a wardrobe that they can layer, so that changes are minimal. If photographing in my studio, there is a seperate dressing area. Remember, we will be

using ambient light (the sun) for many outdoor locations. If you are wanting more than one location, I ask that travel time between the two be at a minimal (no more than 20 minutes). With a two location session, travel time is included as part of this two hour session.

What will my session be like?

Prior to your session, we will discuss locations (studio, location, or both). At each location, we will spend some time looking at your wardrobe and discussing the looks you're wanting to create. Please arrive with your hair (and make up) in your preferred style (i.e. strait, curly, wavy).

On location and in the studio, we will create images that range in expression and natural poses that capture the authentic you. I will photograph as many images as I can during your session (expect an average of 60 images in an hour - these images are not retouched).

My mantra is, 'Senior Portraits are FUN.' Allow this to be a playful relaxing process.

Is a makeup artist available?

Professional hair and make-up services are available, but are an additional fee. A professional make-up artist will even out skin tone, cover blemishes, and have you looking your best.

How should I dress for my Senior session?

Wardrobe is a tool used to compliment your portrait. My advice is to keep your wardrobe simple, and choose pieces that will give you a range of looks. I encourage seniors to bring 3-4 outfits. I will assist in making the final selections of wardrobe based on the looks we plan to create in the session.

Other tips:

- Bring a range of color in wardrobe.
- I recommend clothing darker than your skin tone.
- Black is fine, but try to avoid white.
- Bring clothing that is solid in color.
- Avoid tops that have logos, stripes, and busy prints.
- Jewelry is fine, but should not be too distracting.

Please press your clothes before arriving to your session. We want to avoid as many wrinkles as possible in your images.

Do I receive proofs and how long does that take?

Yes! All packages include on-line proofs and a proof CD. On-line proofs will be posted within days of your session. Having proofs online allows you to easily show friends and family members your fun images. Your proofs will remain on my website for 60 days. Please make your order requests within that time. After 60 days I will remove your images from my site.

How do I order my proofs?

When ordering prints, there are two options for seniors and their parents. A senior can schedule a 30 minute appointment with me or they can send their order to my e-mail account.

With appointments, I ask each senior to bring a parent with him/her. Also, please have the images you're wanting and the size print written down. You will notice that each proof picture has a number directly below it. Simply write the number of the proof and the size image you're wanting (i.e. Proof #4 - 8x10).

Please allow 7-10 business days for print orders. Prints can be picked up at my studio in St. Paul. Prints can be shipped to you at an additional fee.

Can I order my senior yearbook picture first and then order the rest of my prints at a later time?

Yes! It's best to order your yearbook photo three weeks prior to its due date. I can e-mail the image to your yearbook or to you. Whatever you prefer. Ala carte prints can be ordered at the same time or a later date. Please note, I do delete senior files six months after the session date. If seniors are wanting a CD or DVD of all their session images they will be invited to do so before the files are erased.

What are my payment options?:

- Cash
- Check
- Money order
- PayPal

Do I need to pay a deposit prior to my session?

Yes, a deposit of \$100 is required to reserve your session date. Your deposit is due five business days before your session. I accept check, cash, money order, or pay pal for your deposit. You can mail your deposit to my studio in St. Paul (see website for address) or arrange a time to drop it off. Payroll is also an option to pay your deposit.

When do I pay the balance for my session?

Your remaining balance is due at the time of the session. Senior Flex Package customers, please be aware that if you pay with a check, your digital negatives will be mailed to you once your check has cleared. To leave the session with your images use one of the other payment options.

Can I have an invoice or receipt?

Yes, invoices are available upon request.

What if I need to cancel my session?

You must cancel session 3 days prior to the session date or you will forfeit your \$100 deposit.

Do you offer any discounts?

Yes! Book individual sessions with a friend and you each save 10% off your session.

Can I have a CD-ROM of all the session's images?

Digital negative files are available for purchase to all Print Package clients (please note – all digital negative files will be deleted 60 days after your session). See the current price list (above).
